

demo instructions



Click and drag to spin the world
hold F3 and click where you want to zoom in
right-click, and go to the Viewpoints submenu.



You can choose a precision viewpoint from the list.
First, choose <Vp-33-151 - sydney>



There will be a pause as the graphics load
for the 3D model of sydney.
When the textures are loaded, right-click again.



New viewpoints will be available - choose <nsw>.
You can cycle through the viewpoints
by pressing page down on your keyboard.



Right-click and go to the Movement menu.
Fly mode will allow you to fly freely throughout the city.
You can hold down SHIFT on your keyboard to go faster.



Click on objects for metadata about them.
You will hear the sounds of Chromacy Yellow, an audio artwork
in the forecourt of the Museum of Contemporary Art.



You can choose the <<< Orbit >>> viewpoint to start again.
Change the Movement back to Examine mode to spin the earth
then hit reload on your Web browser to clear the viewpoints
that loaded when you visited Sydney.



Now try other precision viewpoints.
Go to <Vp42-25 - Italy>, then <Dolomites>; then Fly.
If you have a scrollwheel, you can use it to look up and down.



From <tasmania>, choose <<beach>>; then Fly
Feel free to explore; try going back to <<orbit>>
You can zoom anywhere with F3 - Down from space,
or through the canyons of Sydney and the Dolomites.
